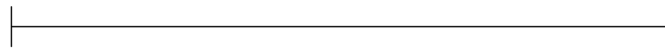




## RING SIZE GUIDE

For the following ways of measurement, it is necessary to print this page in an A4 page size. To make sure it is printed properly, place a credit card on the box below and ensure that it fits well.



**CREDIT CARD BOX**

Find out your ring size:

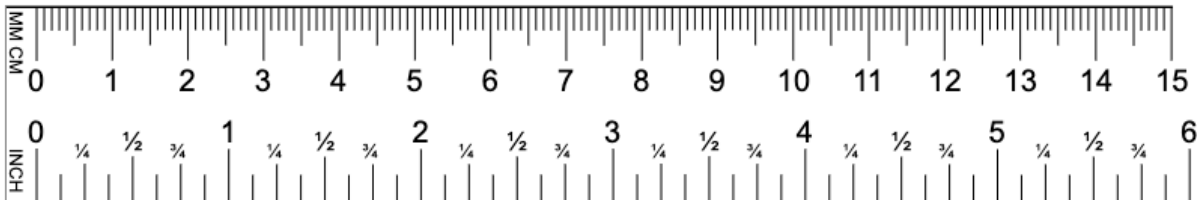
# 1

Use a ribbon or a string and wrap it around the base of your finger. To make sure it fits well, also measure your knuckle. Then use a pen to mark the point where the sides of the string meet. Then measure the string in mm on a ruler. The string should fit comfortably and give an accurate indication of size. Refer to the size chart to determine your size.

If the ideal fit is between two sizes, we suggest you choose the larger size.

# 2

Use the tape measure. Cut the tape measure, wrap it around your finger and write the measurement down. Refer to the size chart to determine your size.

## **TIPS**

- ◆ As the ring size depends on the width of the ring, for a ring that is wider, choose 1-2 sizes larger.
- ◆ Avoid measuring your fingers when they are cold or wet, as the size may vary.

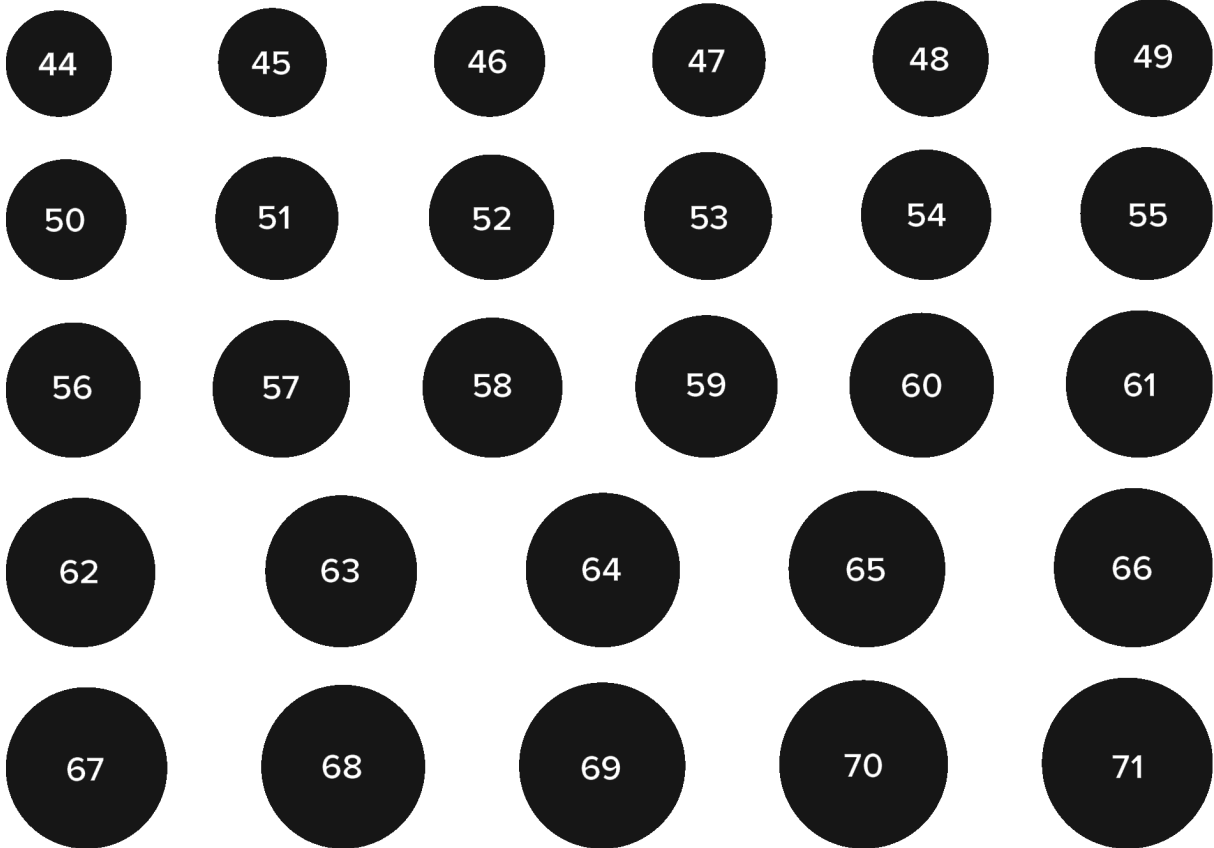

Use an existing ring that fits you comfortably, like a simple wedding ring. Match the inside of that ring with one of the circles below. When your ring has been placed on the right size, you should see only the white inside of the circle and not the black line inside your ring. If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we suggest you choose the larger size.
